Tigertail is a very useful and versatile jewelry making wire, which is nylon coated. It can be used for simple bead stringing or with various findings to create "floating" beaded pieces.

Lesson 7

Workshop - Hair accessories
Creating simple hair accessories suitable for weddings or other special occasions

Lesson 8

Presentation - Personal project
Exploring various materials, ideas and techniques to come up with an individual piece of jewelry
